The Post was chartered in 1919 by Veterans of World War One. The building and brick walkway were completed by the members in 1939.

The Post has been active for over 100 years supporting veterans, their families, engaging in community activities, helping to develop our youth through athletics and academic programs.

The members of the Post have been the Honor Guard of the Doylestown's Memorial Parade continuously since 1917 except for 2017, when the parade was cancelled.

The Post is a meeting place for VFW, VVA, Marine Corp League, Lions, DAV, and veteran's event such as We support youth baseball, a Scout Troop Civil Air Patrol, AA. It is available for rent to local community organizations and individuals.

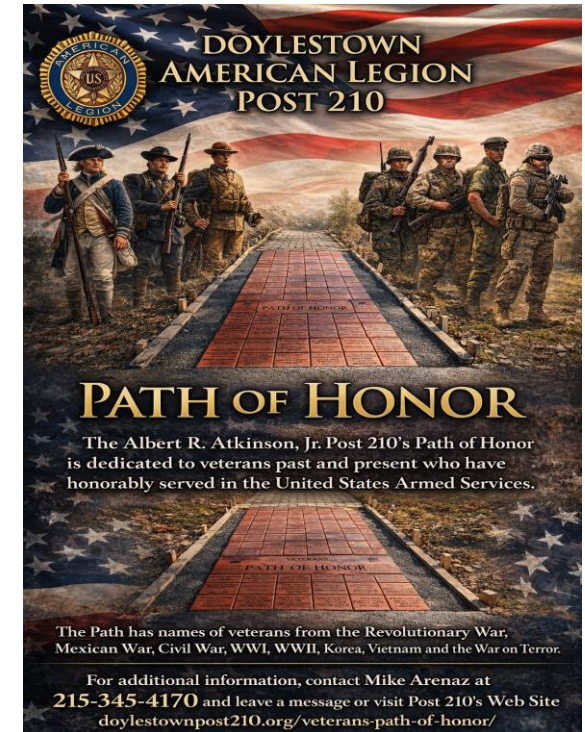
The third section is completed. The bricks for the fourth section will be placed in October 2025.
